The RPP Core has partnered with injury control researchers nationwide to build an online data warehouse. The Kids' Inpatient Database (KID) and Nationwide Emergency Department Sample (NEDS) are important sources of hospital-based data, provided by the Healthcare Cost and Utilization Project and the Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality. These sources include weighted samples of ED visits and hospital admissions, making them very useful for studying patient populations.
